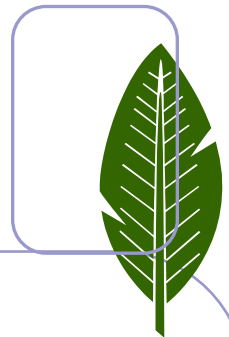
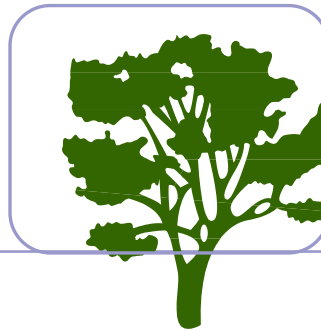


JOIN THE BINGHAM FARMS GREEN TEAM!

GREEN TEAM AMBASSADOR PROGRAM:

EACH CLASSROOM in grades 1-5 has the chance to appoint 1-3 Green Team Ambassadors. (4th grade may have up to 4. Appointed 4th grade ambassadors will serve the kindergarten classrooms.)

Ambassadors attend lunchtime Green Team Meetings and bring back Green Team projects and messages to their classrooms.

Each Classroom can appoint their Green Team Ambassadors as the teacher sees fit. We are looking for enthusiastic, interested, hardworking students who can communicate Green Team information with their classrooms. We hope to have **at least one** Ambassador per class at each Green Team lunchtime meeting.
